


Balticon 57 opened Friday night with a recognition of *Guest of Honor* Jane Yolen, whose son Adam Stemple received her award and spoke about her. Technical Difficulties 2.0 was welcomed as the *Music Guest of Honor*, and Ariel Burgess as the *Artist Guest of Honor*. Brian "Bellz" Jordan was announced as the *Fan Guest of Honor*, and received his award in a flamboyant devil's costume. Lynn Cox spoke in remembrance of the *Ghost of Honor*, Daphne E. Arthur. The Compton Crook winners from 2021 and 2022 (Micaiah Johnson and P.Djèlí Clark) presented the *2023 Compton Crook Award* to Alex Jennings for *The Ballad of Perilous Graves*. Dr. Beatrice Kondo presented the *2023 Robert Heinlein Award* to John Scalzi, known for *Red Shirts* and *Old Man's War*, among others. Scalzi spoke of the importance of paying one's privilege forward, and will be giving a talk about the contributions of Robert Heinlein in his own life and writings.
